As per the Energy Conservation Policy committee's resolutions issued on November 26, 2009 and presided over by the Prime Minister, it is mutually deemed appropriate to pursue the energy conservation policies for the designated building of both government and state enterprise sectors, where Permanent Secretaries of all ministries (independent regulatory agencies included) are required to notify the designated buildings' Chiefs of both government and state enterprise sectors to pursue the Energy Conservation Promotion Act.

1. AOT will develop the most appropriate energy management plan as part of the organizational goals to be achieved, which is consistent to the required laws and other related regulatory guidelines.
2. AOT will proceed with effective improvement of energy consumption appropriately and consistently complying with the application of modern technology and good corporate governance.
3. AOT will identify targeted plans and goals on energy conservation on a yearly basis and will encourage all employees to practice according to the energy conservation plan to achieve the organization's targeted goals comprehensibly and precisely.

4. AOT will always consider the energy conservation promotion as mutual responsibility of executives and employees at all levels, where they shall cooperate in practicing, monitoring and reporting of energy management in accordance with the specified policies.
5. AOT will offer reasonable and necessary supports to the management of human resources, budget, training and opinion expressing aiming for greater energy development.
6. Executives and committee members involved in the organization's energy management will generate greater development plans and targeted goals for effective energy management every year.
